Minutes of the LIFE CLIMATREE Kick-off Meeting

Date: 7- 8 October 2015

Location: Agricultural University of Athens - Agricultural Museum Hall Subject: Kick-off Meeting for the Life Project (LIFE14CCM/GR/00635)

1st Day: 7th October 2015

- A representative of the Ministry for the Environment, Energy & Climate Change Green Fund made a short address opening the LIFE CLIMATREE kick off meeting
- The LIFE CLIMATREE Project Coordinator (Prof. Kostas Bithas UEHR) welcomed the attendees and presented the outline of the Project
- Prof. D. Kardaras AUEB, made a short presentation of the "Software Interface development" providing some initial details on its possible development
- The associated beneficiary TERRA NOVA (I. Spanos) presented the main administrative and financial procedures of the project (Financial Management, Timesheets, TES etc.)
- LIFE CONOPS Project Coordinator (A. Michaelakis -Benakeion Phytopathological Institute) shared his experience from managing and coordinating another Life Project underlying key issues that all beneficiaries should keep in mind while coordinating LIFE CLIMATREEs development
- A meeting of the Technical and Financial Committee took place in order to define the procedures for quality control of the LIFE CLIMATREE progress.

Prof. Bithas presented his suggestions on the definition of a methodology for the control of deliverables, through an internal "reviewing" process and the rest of the beneficiaries shared their thoughts and agreed.

Regarding the delineation of the financial procedures, the LIFE CLIMATREE's timesheets, accompanied by other relevant financial documents, were agreed to be sent to the LIFE CLIMATREE Project Coordinator (UEHR) every 3 months.

All the beneficiaries were reminded to study carefully the new guidelines "General Conditions".

Lastly, it was reminded that on all invoices from suppliers and subcontractors, there should be a clear reference to the project, thus the preparation of the official stamp of LIFE project, in accordance to the requested format was decided.

• In order to organize the project actions' workload, the Scientific Committee made a detailed presentation of the 3 Preparatory Actions:

A.1: Selection and analysis of tree-crop categories in S. Europe (AUA)

A.2: Adjustment of the "Land use, land-use change and forestry (LULUCF) Methodology" to the environmental problem targeted (DICEM)

A.3: Analysis of climatic, environmental and socioeconomic parameters of tree-crop categories in S. Europe (UOWM)

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2nd Day: 8th October 2015

• At the beginning of the day the Scientific Committee continued with the detailed presentation of the remaining Actions:

C.1: Life Cycle Assessment of carbon cycle in tree-crop categories (AUA) C.2: Projections of future climatic conditions for tree crop categories in S. Europe (UOWM) C.4: Carbon input / output calculation for current and future years (TN) C.3:Interface development of a software application for accounting tree-crop carbon sequestration (UEHR) C.5: Suggestions of Climate Change Mitigation policies and measures (UEHR) D.1: Evaluation of the effectiveness of the proposed policies and measures (DICEM) D.2: Assessment of the socioeconomic impact of the project's outputs (UEHR) D.3: Assessment of the impact of the proposed methodology in supporting the ecosystem function restoration (CSIC)

- To streamline the essential work of the LIFE CLIMATREE's Project four (4) workshops took place:
 - 1. Agricultural Workload Organized and Coordinated by (AUA)
 - 2. Climate Change Workload Organized and Coordinated by (UOWM)
 - 3. Economics- Organized and Coordinated by (UEHR)
 - 4. Ecosystem Services & Sustainability Organized and Coordinated by (CSIC)

An exchange of ideas and thoughts took place within this stage. The coordinators of the 4 "workshops" presented their suggestions on the roadmap for the production of various deliverables. The rest of the beneficiaries presented their counter-suggestions, objections and common lines. A primary schedule was agreed for the production of LIFE CLIMATREEs first deliverables.

The contents of the most urgent deliverables (especially A.1) were discussed and agreed.

- In the last section of the 2nd day a meeting of the Management and Dissemination Committee, took place.
- A. Kolimenakis (UEHR) presented the following Actions: E.3: Dissemination of project's progress and results F.1: Project management by UEHR F.2: Monitoring of project progress F.3: Networking activities with other relevant EU projects,

remarking the important dates and benchmarks for the coordination of LIFE CLIMATREEs administrative and dissemination actions.

Regarding the organization of LIFE CLIMATREE's networking strategy all beneficiaries were reminded to create a list of relevant EU Projects in order to initiate a communication and exchange of good practices.

Finally, suggestions for the next meeting were presented as well as initial thoughts for the transfer of the Mid-term report in an earlier (than the indicated in the proposal) date.
